Please see the list below for the supplies that will be required for all students in grades 6 to 9. Supplies can be found at stationary stores such as: Dream Depot, Alpha and Morning Glory. These supplies are used individually and communally among the students as needed.

If there are any materials that can be re-used from last year, such as backpacks and binders, please reuse them! The KFS community feels that reducing waste and our footprints on the Earth is extremely important. It may be beneficial to have a conversation with your child(ren) about the use of materials in school. (i.e. Use only what you need, take care of materials such as glue, crayons, scissors and pencils so that they are not lost or wasted.) Practicing responsible use of materials at home and at school are encouraged.
